Sharing Baseline Monitoring Information and Looking Ahead to Long-Term Monitoring

- The *State of the California North Coast Region* report, a synopsis of ecological, biological, oceanographic, and socio-economic conditions during the initial phase of monitoring.
- The status of California’s MPA Management Program, including next steps for long-term MPA monitoring.

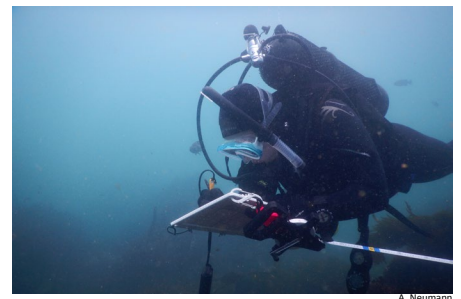
All are welcome, including those interested in the monitoring and adaptive management of California’s MPAs.
